



COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PLAN SNAPSHOT

August 18, 2021

How we're ensuring people know how to keep themselves safe from exposure

- Contractors, workers, volunteers, and artists are informed of the plan and communication of changes is ongoing.
- Communication also includes a volunteer orientation and daily safety talks.
- Patrons are informed through the website, social media accounts, email, including newsletters, and the online booking system.

How we're screening for COVID-19

- Contractors, workers, volunteers, and artists – daily active screening; contact records retained for 30 days
- Patrons (North Paid Area) – daily active screening; contact records retained for 30 days
- Patrons (South Free Area – except the Southstage Bar tent) – daily passive screening on entry
- Patrons (South Free Area – Southstage Bar tent) – daily passive screening on entry; contact information collected and retained for 30 days

How we're controlling the risk of transmission

Hand and Respiratory Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer and hand washing stations are provided throughout the site.

Physical Distancing

- Contractors, workers, volunteers, and artists will maintain 2 metres of physical distancing.
- Alternatively, plexiglass or some other impermeable barrier or personal protective equipment (medical mask and face shield, safety glasses or goggles) will be provided.
- Patrons must maintain 2 metres of physical distancing between every person outside their household.
- Security and volunteers will monitor and remind patrons of physical distancing requirements. Non-compliance may result in removal from the site by security without refund.

Masks / Face Coverings and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Every contractor, workers, volunteers, and artist must wear a **mask or face covering**, unless entitled to an exception as noted in the regulation.
- Every patron must wear a **mask or face covering** unless:
 - Seated with members of their own household only, and every member of the household is seated at least two (2) metres from every person outside their household.
 - Entitled to an exception as noted in the regulation
- Non-compliance may result in removal from the site by security.

- When physical distancing of two (2) metres cannot be maintained and there is no separation by a barrier, PPE such as medical masks and eye protection (face shield, safety glasses or goggles) must be worn.

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Washrooms, tables, chairs, point of sale payment devices and other high touch, shared surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected as frequently as is necessary to maintain a sanitary condition.
- Onstage and backstage equipment will be cleaned and disinfected between artists.

Other

- Dancing is not permitted in tents.
- If patrons dance in other areas, they must wear masks or face coverings and maintain two (2) metres of physical distance from other people.

What we will do if there is a potential case, or suspected exposure to, COVID-19

- Follow all Peel Public Health instructions.

How we're managing any new risks caused by the changes made to the way we operate?

- Protocols will be followed mitigate risks at the event.

How we're making sure our plan is working

- Walk-throughs each day on site to verify compliance with controls, to document any exceptions and to take corrective actions.
- Daily communicate to review compliance with protocols, issues that have been brought forward, incident reports, and patron feedback to identify any corrective actions that may be required.
